

A. Brief Historical Background

- Phu Tha Byu The first Karen Baptist convert through the ministry of the American Baptist pioneer missionary Adoniram Judson.
- Baptized at Dawei by George Dana Boardman, on May 16, 1828, at the age of 50.
- Turned to a flaming evangelist.
- Died September 9, 1840, at age 62,
- 1270 Baptized members among the Karens.
- Was given title of "The Karen Apostle"
- Local Karen Baptist Churches were organized as Association.
- In 1913, 12 Regional Associations organized & establis hed KBC.
- Now KBC has 20 Regional Associations and 1793 churches.






